D.C. Administration's current proposal:

- DCHA to develop 300+ Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) units with no market-rate units (aka: 100% public housing) (note: the Robeson School can be torn down and replaced with a building of up to 6 stories)
- No on-site parking
