



## WINES BY THE GLASS & BOTTLE

### ESPUMOSOS

**DOMAINE BOUSQUET | BRUT ROSÉ | NV | TUPUNGATO, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA | 10 | 38**

A 75/25 Pinot/Chard blend of estate-grown fruit from Tupungato, this rosé tastes of tart raspberry and orange oil.

**CAVE AMADEU | BRUT ROSÉ | PINTO BANDEIRA - SERRA GAÚCHA, BRAZIL | 62**

This manages to be both bone-dry and ebulliently fruity, with flavors of mixed berries and tongue-smacking freshness.

### BLANCOS

**GARZÓN | ALBARIÑO | 2016 | GARZÓN, URUGUAY | 13 | 48**

In Uruguay, Galicia's signature white grape produces a wine of laser-sharp acidity and sea breeze. Great with ceviche.

**ESTACIÓN PORVENIR | SAUVIGNON BLANC | 2016 | VALLE DE GUADALUPE, MEXICO | 12 | 44**

A round, full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc with acidity, viscosity, and a slight salinity characteristic to Baja wines.

**ZUCCARDI SERIE A | TORRONTÉS | 2016 | SALTA, ARGENTINA | 11 | 40**

The 2016 has the same floral aromas and flavor of lychee as the 2015, but seems to be fresher and livelier on the palate.

**VISTALAGO | RIESLING BLEND | 2017 | VALLE DEL MAULE, CHILE | 13 | 48**

Intensely aromatic, almost more Gewurz-y, with some Chard and Torontel blended in. Perfect with whole fish or clams.

**CATENA | CHARDONNAY | 2015 | VISTA FLORES, ARGENTINA | 12 | 44**

A bright Chard with notes of pineapple, yellow delicious apples, and a hint of talcum.

**ANIELLO | BLANCO DE PINOT NOIR | 2016 | RIO NEGRO, PATAGONIA, ARGENTINA | 13 | 48**

A cool, unique wine, this smells faintly of strawberries, but tastes like tree fruits: peaches and apples. Medium to full-bodied. The perfect cool-weather white.

**ZORZAL ROSÉ (TERROIR ÚNICO) | PINOT NOIR | 2017 | GUALTALLARY - VALLE DE TUPUNGATO, ARGENTINA | 10 | 36**

Tense, fresh rosé showing notes of strawberry with a bitter fruit-pit note on the finish.

### TINTOS

**APALTAGUA | PINOT NOIR | 2016 | VALLE DE SAN ANTONIO, CHILE | 12 | 44**

This Pinot is grown just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean, producing a silky, feminine wine with a velvety texture and a hint of spice.

**BICHI | NO SAPIENS FIELD BLEND | 2016 | TECATE, MEXICO | 64**

Wild natural wine from old vines in Tecate, the owners aren't even sure what grapes these are. Light-bodied with zippy acidity and fascinating aromatics. For wine geeks.

**J. BRIX | "ROUGAROU" CARIGNAN | 2015 | MCCORMICK RANCH VINEYARD, SAN DIEGO COUNTY, USA | 68**

We broke our "only Latin America" rule for this wine. A 90-case-per-year old-vine Carignan from San Diego County that offers bright, crunchy cranberry fruit? What is this? #unicornwine

**VILLARD | SYRAH | 2015 | VALLE DE CASABLANCA, CHILE | 13 | 48**

It's the classic story: Frenchman marries Chilean woman, son makes one of the best value Syrahs on Earth. Plums, bacon, and wild strawberries.

**VIÑA ALICIA | MORENA | 2009 | LUJAN DE CUYO, ARGENTINA | 72**

An 88/12 blend of Cabernet Sauvignon/Cabernet Franc, this shows 8 years of bottle age well. Black currants, a touch of singed wood, saddle leather.

**CASAS DEL BOSQUE | GRAN RESERVA CABERNET SAUVIGNON | 2016 | VALLE DEL MAIPO, CHILE | 12 | 44**

Balanced Cabernet with black currants, moderate tannins, and a cedary note. James Suckling awarded the 2014 94 points.

**CATENA | MALBEC | 2015 | LUNLUNTA, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA | 14 | 54**

This is all smoked meat, blood, and Bing cherries. We have a lot of wines for parrillada; this might be the best value of all.

**GARZÓN | TANNAT | 2015 | GARZÓN, URUGUAY | 13 | 48**

This Tannat is dark and extracted, with power but great balance, too. Flavors of black plums with remarkable length.

**FAMILIA DEIGAS | TANNAT | 2015 | MAR DE PIEDRAS VINEYARD, URUGUAY | 75**

Awesome single-vineyard Tannat grown on schist at the foot of Mount Mahoma. Stony minerality, moderate tannins, and a pen-ink note on the palate. A fascinating wine that truly evolves in the glass.

**BODEGA ALEANNA | EL ENEMIGO BONARDA | 2014 | MENDOZA, ARGENTINA | 16 | 62**

Big and ripe, this combines a beautiful floral note with some serious flavors of beef blood/iron and black currants. Screams out for meat.

**BODEGA BOUZA | TANNAT | 2015 | "B6" SINGLE VINEYARD, CANELONES, URUGUAY | 94**

This is both massive and intoxicatingly aromatic, with spice, black and blue fruits, and tannins that mean business. Uruguay consumes more beef per capita than any other country. This wine could be part of the reason why.

**ZUCCARDI | "JOSE ZUCCARDI" MALBEC | 2013 | VALLE DE UCO, ARGENTINA | 164 (1.5L)**

An explosion of cracked black pepper, brambly blackberry, and grabby tannins. One of the best Malbecs on earth, in a festive magnum format.
